# NEW BUSINESS

<u>National Sign Services, LLC</u> - Variance #2010-1 - to allow a larger free standing business sign for the CVS store at 606 South Main Street.

Stacey Morgan, representing National Sign Services, LLC, presented the application for a dimensional variance to increase the size of the sign. They are asking for a 92.7 sq. ft. pylon sign to be placed at the corner of the property along South Main Street, closest to the dentist's office. The sign is designed to complement the store. The upper portion of the sign will be CVS Pharmacy, with a message board underneath. The property has 2 frontages with a total of 525 lineal feet including both of the frontages. The Ordinance allows 32 sq. feet/100 lineal feet. The height of the sign satisfies the Ordinance.

M. Lee stated that during the land development process, Borough Council spent considerable time stressing that larger signs will not be allowed. They must conform to the Ordinance. Since it is a corner lot, the Ordinance allows a

- G. Smith stated that there is not an issue with visibility therefore, he doesn't see a need for a larger sign.

  R. Fisher said he does not see a hardship and pointed out that the message board cannot use specific colors, because of the proximity of the signal light. R. Palmer questioned whether they could shrink the CVS portion of the sign to allow for the message board, and meet the Ordinance requirements.
- G. Smith made the motion to recommend that the size of the sign must meet the Ordinance, therefore, not allowed to be larger. J. Buck seconded the motion. The motion carried with all in favor.
