RESOLUTION PURSUANT TO ORDINANCE NO. 2012-03 REGARDING SOLICITING AND PEDDLING WITHIN SHREWSBURY BOROUGH

WHEREAS, Borough Council adopted Ordinance No. 2012-03, regulating soliciting and peddling within Shrewsbury Borough; and

WHEREAS, Section 5 of Ordinance No. 2012-03 authorizes the Borough to charge a certificate fee in the amount of \$10.00 or an amount established by the Borough by resolution; and

WHEREAS, the Borough desires to revise the certificate fee and provide an additional requirements.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of Shrewsbury Borough that:

- 1. The certificate fee under Ordinance No. 2012-03 shall be \$25.00; and
- 2. The Applicant seeking a certificate shall be required to attend the next regularly scheduled meeting of Shrewsbury Borough Council, which occurs at least 2 weeks following the application filing date, to receive a decision as to whether a certificate is granted. The failure to appear at such Council meeting can and shall be a sufficient basis to deny the requested certificate.

ORDINANCE NO. 2012-03

AN ORDINANCE OF SHREWSBURY BOROUGH, YORK COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA REGULATING SOLICITING AND PEDDLING WITHIN SHREWSBURY BOROUGH, REQUIRING SOLICITORS AND PEDDLERS TO OBTAIN A CERTIFICATE OF REGISTRATION, ESTABLISHING REGISTRATION FEES, AND PROVIDING FOR THE ENFORCEMENT THEREOF AND PENALTIES FOR THE VIOLATION THEREOF.

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED, and it is hereby enacted and ordained by the Shrewsbury Borough Council, York County, Pennsylvania, under authority of law as follows:

SECTION 1: DEFINITIONS. For the purpose of this Ordinance, the following words used herein shall be considered to have the meaning set forth in this section:

- A. Soliciting shall mean and include any one or more of the following activities:
- 1. Seeking to obtain orders for the purchase of goods, wares, merchandise, foodstuffs, services of any kind, character or description whatever, for any kind of consideration whatever, for future delivery, or
- 2. Seeking to obtain prospective customers for application or purchase of insurance of any type, kind, or publication; or
- 3. Seeking to obtain subscriptions to books, magazines, periodicals, newspapers and every other type or kind of publication; or
- 4. Seeking to obtain gifts or contributions of money, clothing, or any other valuable thing for the support or benefit of any charitable or nonprofit association, organization, corporation, or project, not otherwise exempted by the provisions of this Ordinance.
- B. **Peddling** shall mean the selling of any goods, wares, merchandise, foodstuffs, or services for immediate delivery, but shall not include delivery of regular orders taken previously.
- C. Residence shall mean and include every separate living unit occupied for residential purposes by one or more persons, contained within any type of building or structure.

- D. Registered Solicitor or Peddler shall mean and include any person who has obtained a valid certificate of registration as provided in this Ordinance, which certificate is in the possession of the Solicitor or Peddler while engaged in soliciting or peddling.
- E. Person shall mean any natural person, association, partnership, firm, organization or corporation.
- SECTION 2: CERTIFICATE OF REGISTRATION. Every person desiring to engage in soliciting or peddling, as herein defined, unless exempted by the provisions of Section 3 of this Ordinance, from Persons in residences or upon the roads, highways, sidewalks or alleys within Shrewsbury Borough is hereby required to make written application for a certificate of registration as provided in this Ordinance. Such certificate shall be carried by the Solicitor or Peddler at all times while engaged in soliciting or peddling within Shrewsbury Borough.
- <u>SECTION 3:</u> EXEMPTIONS. The registration requirements of Section 2 of this Ordinance shall not be applicable to the following:
 - A. Farmers seeking or taking orders for the sale of their own products;
- B. Public or charitable activities within Shrewsbury Borough or that serves and specifically benefits the residents of Shrewsbury Borough, when the activities are being conducted for the enjoyment and well-being of the community;
- C. Charitable organizations exempted from the registration requirements of Act of the Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania of April 30, 1986, P.L. 107, as amended 10 P.S. Section 162.1 et seq.
- D. Boy Scout, Girl Scout, and similar scouting or other youth organizations sponsored by non-profit organizations, municipal or school district.
- E. Candidates, or their representatives who are duly authorized in writing, seeking a public office that serves the residents of Shrewsbury Borough.
- F. Snowball, snow cone, ice-cream or similar vans or trucks, where the point of sale of snowballs, snow cones, ice-cream, or frozen treats is in the street at the sidewalk, and not at the door of a person's residence.
- SECTION 4: APPLICATION FOR CERTIFICATE OF REGISTRATION. Every person desiring to engage in soliciting or peddling in Shrewsbury Borough shall first make application to the Shrewsbury Borough Municipal Office, to the attention of the Secretary or other duly authorized representative of Shrewsbury Borough for a certificate of registration. The application shall be made upon a form provided by the Shrewsbury Borough and shall contain at least the following information about the applicant verified by oath or affirmation:
 - A. Full name and local address, if any.
 - B. Permanent address.

- C. Name of employer or a statement that such applicant is self-employed.
- D. Contact and personal information, including but not limited to, a cellular telephone number, e-mail address, and social security number for applicant and any person who will be in the Borough.
- E. The nature of the goods, wares, services or merchandise offered for sale, or the purpose of the organization and the nature of the solicitations being made.
- F. A statement as to whether or not the applicant has ever been convicted of any crime, and if the answer is in the affirmative, the nature of the offense or offenses and the punishments imposed therefor. The Borough reserves the right to investigate the criminal background of the applicant, at the applicant's cost. By submitting an application, the applicant authorizes such investigation.
 - G. The type of vehicle(s) to be used, if any.
- H. Upon request, the applicant shall also submit to finger printing, which shall be conducted at the cost of Shrewsbury Borough, and furnish a photograph.
 - I. Produce verification, license or identification.

When applying for a certificate of registration, the applicant shall authorize Shrewsbury Borough to verify the information provided upon the form. The applicant also shall agree that the certificate of registration may be denied if the Secretary, or other duly authorized representative of Shrewsbury Borough, determines that the applicant has:

- A. Failed to complete the registration form.
- B. Provided fraudulent information on the registration form.
- C. Made false or fraudulent statements or misrepresentations while soliciting or peddling.
 - D. Violated any local, state or federal laws.
 - E. Trespassed while soliciting or peddling.
 - F. Ceased to possess the qualifications required to obtain the permit.

Where a person makes application for himself/herself and one or more helpers, all applicable personal information specified above shall be given by him/her, and an individual certificate shall be required for each helper. No certificate under this article shall be transferable from one person to another.

Shrewsbury Borough shall attempt to process all applications for certificate of registration within five (5) business days of the receipt thereof.

Applicant may challenge denial of the permit by requesting in writing a hearing before Borough Council.

SECTION 5: CERTIFICATE FEE. No certificate shall be issued under this Ordinance until the sum of Ten Dollars (\$10.00) shall be paid to Shrewsbury Borough (the "Certificate Fee"). This Certificate Fee may be changed from time to time by the Shrewsbury Borough Council by Resolution. A separate application shall be filed and a separate permit fee shall be paid by each person who shall actually conduct the soliciting or peddling, including where an employer desires to secure certificates for his employees, agents or servants. If the Borough incurs any additional costs in processing the application, the applicant shall reimburse them.

SECTION 6: TERM. The certificate granted pursuant to this article shall be valid for thirty (30) days after the date of such certificate and, upon the expiration of any certificate, if the person holding the same shall desire to continue or renew soliciting or peddling, he/she shall be required to file a new application for a permit and pay a new fee. Such certificates may be issued, in advance, for consecutive thirty (30) day periods not exceeding four (4) in number, upon payment, in advance, of the Certificate Fee for each thirty (30) day period provided in Section 5.

SECTION 7: CERTIFICATE EXHIBITION. Such certificate, when issued, shall state, inter alia, the products to be sold or services rendered by the holder. Every Solicitor or Peddler shall at all times, when engaged in soliciting or peddling within Shrewsbury Borough, carry such certificate upon his/her person and shall exhibit it upon request to all police officers, Borough officials and citizens. No Solicitor or Peddler shall engage in selling any product or service not mentioned on such certificate.

SECTION 8: NOTICE REGULATING SOLICITING. Every person desiring to secure the protection provided by the regulations pertaining to soliciting or peddling contained in this Ordinance including those exempted from registration shall comply with the following:

Notice of the determination by the occupant of any residence of the refusal of invitation to Solicitors, Peddlers, or uninvited guests to the residence shall be given by exhibiting a card, at least three inches by four inches in size, upon or near the main entrance door to the residence containing the words "No Solicitors Invited" or "No Solicitors" or "No Soliciting" or some other phrase that shall give notice to Solicitors or Peddlers. The letters shall be at least one-third inch in height and such card so exhibited shall constitute sufficient notice to any Solicitor, Peddler, or uninvited guest of the determination by the occupant of the residence of the information contained thereon.

SECTION 9: DUTY OF SOLICITORS OR PEDDLERS. It shall be the duty of every Solicitor or Peddler whether or not required to secure a certificate of registration upon going into any premises in Shrewsbury Borough upon which a residence is located to first examine the notice provided for in this Ordinance, if any is attached, and be governed by the statement contained on any notice. If such a notice is posted, then the Solicitor or Peddler shall immediately and peacefully depart from the premises. Any Solicitor or Peddler who has gained

entrance to any residence whether invited or not shall immediately and peacefully depart from the premises when requested to do so by the occupant. The applicant, and any person who is a solicitor or peddler, shall be available by cellular phone during said activities or if not by cellular telephone, then by other means as directed by the Borough, including but not limited to, periodically checking in with the Borough to provide updates during the term of the Certificate. The Borough may impose additional duties following written notice to the applicant, which written notice may be done by resolution or motion adopted prior to submission of an application or in correspondence with the applicant during the application process.

SECTION 10: UNINVITED SOLICITING OR PEDDLING PROHIBITED. It is hereby declared to be unlawful and shall constitute a nuisance for any person to go upon any premises and ring the doorbell upon or near any door, or create any sound in any other manner calculated to attract the attention of the occupant of such residence, for the purpose of securing an audience with the occupant thereof and engage in soliciting or peddling in defiance of the notice exhibited at the residence in accordance with the provisions of Section 8 of this Ordinance,

SECTION 11: TIME LIMIT. It is hereby declared to be unlawful and shall constitute a nuisance for any person whether registered under this Ordinance or not to go upon any premises and ring the doorbell upon or near any door of a residence located thereon or rap or knock upon any door or create any sound in any other manner calculated to attract the attention of the occupant of such residence for the purpose of securing an audience with the occupant thereof and engage in soliciting or peddling prior to 9:00 a.m. or after 7:00 p.m. of any weekday and Saturday, or at any time on a Sunday or on a state or national holiday. Such time shall be the prevailing time, whether Eastern Standard Time or Daylight Saving Time.

SECTION 12: PARKING VEHICLE ON STREET; LITTERING. No person, whether or not registered as a Solicitor or Peddler under this Ordinance, shall park any vehicle upon any of the streets, highways or alleys of Shrewsbury Borough in order to sort, rearrange or clean any of his goods, wares, services or merchandise. No such person shall place or deposit any refuse on any such streets, highways or alleys. No such person shall maintain or keep a street or curbstone market by parking any vehicle upon any street or alley in Shrewsbury Borough for any longer than necessary in order to sell therefrom to persons residing in the immediate vicinity.

SECTION 13: FIXED LOCATION PROHIBITED. No person licensed as a Solicitor or Peddler under this Ordinance shall occupy any fixed location upon any of the sidewalks of the streets, highways, alleys or sidewalks of Shrewsbury Borough for the purpose of soliciting or peddling with or without any stand or counter.

SECTION 14: REVOCATION OF CERTIFICATES. Any certificate issued under this Ordinance may be suspended or revoked at any time by any authorized enforcement officer for violation of any of the terms and conditions set forth herein.

SECTION 15: CRYING WARES; USING NOISEMAKERS PROHIBITED. No person registered as a Solicitor or Peddler under this Ordinance shall hawk or cry his/her wares or services upon any of the streets or sidewalks of Shrewsbury Borough, nor shall he/she use any

loud speaker, bell, whistle, or other device for announcing his/her presence by which the public is annoyed.

SECTION 16: PENALTIES. Any person who shall violate any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall, upon conviction thereof, be fined not more than Six Hundred Dollars (\$600.00) and costs of prosecution for each and every separate offense, including, but not limited to, attorneys' fees, or in default of the payment of such fine and costs, undergo imprisonment in the York County Prison for a period of one (1) day for each dollar of fine and costs not paid, such term not to exceed thirty (30) days. For purposes of this Ordinance, there may be multiple violations in a day, for each individual violation of any one or more sections thereof.

SECTION 17: ENFORCEMENT. The provisions of this Ordinance shall be enforced by the Shrewsbury Borough Zoning Officer, any Shrewsbury Borough official appointed from time to time by resolution of the Borough Council or by any police officer having authority within Shrewsbury Borough.

SECTION 18: SEVERABILITY. The provisions of this Ordinance shall be severable, and if any of the provisions or sections shall be declared unconstitutional or illegal by a court of competent jurisdiction, the decision of such court shall not affect the validity of the remaining provisions or sections of this Ordinance. It is hereby declared to be the legislative intent that this Ordinance would have been adopted had such illegal or unconstitutional provisions not been included herein.

<u>SECTION 19:</u> REPEALER. All Ordinances or parts of Ordinances inconsistent herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such consistency.

SECTION 20: EFFECTIVE DATE. This Ordinance shall become effective five (5) days after the date of its enactment as provided by law.
